Personal Alarm Prescription

- 4G Live Life personal falls detector alarms – to be set up with clients' emergency contacts.
To prescribe the LiveLife personal alarm with falls detection, contact details are required to program the alarm with contacts.

The personal contact can use multiple number entries (e.g. Jane Smith work and Jane Smith mobile). It is a maximum of six numbers per device. There is no obligation to use all six contacts.

Discuss the preferred contacts with family/friends/neighbours and send the completed table back to ILCT for processing.
