## Conditions of loan

- **Return of equipment:** Loan equipment remains the property of MND TAS and must be returned to ILCT when no longer required so it is available for other Tasmanians with MND. If you have no way of returning the equipment, please contact your MND advisor.
- **General Care:** You are responsible for the care and general upkeep of the equipment until it is returned to ILCT.
- **Maintenance/repairs:** If you suspect any broken or faulty equipment, please contact ILCT to discuss any necessary repairs or maintenance. We have insurance for loss and accidental damage so please notify us as soon as possible if anything goes missing or gets damaged.
- **Reassessment:** If the equipment on loan no longer meets your needs, please contact your MND Advisor or Support Coordinator to access a reassessment from a health professional.
- **Loan payment:** For NDIS participants, ILCT will invoice your NDIS plan for the agreed loan fees detailed in the loan form on behalf of MND TAS.
